Organize your documents!



Visit CalEITC4Me.org to learn what documents you need to file your tax returns and begin collecting them in a safe place. Your W-2 is one of the most important tax documents. If you haven't received it by February 15th, contact your employer.

Keeping you safe!



If you claim the Federal Earned Income Tax Credit and/or the Additional Child Tax Credit, a new law requires the IRS to hold your federal refund until at least February 15th for protection against identity theft and fraud.

File your taxes for free!



If you made \$54,000 or less in 2017, you can get your taxes filed for free at a VITA location in your community. Free tax preparation means more money back in your pocket this tax season. Find locations near you at CalEITC4Me.org/get-it.

Get your refund for free!



Use direct deposit or a free cash checking service. Don't have a bank account? Visit bankoncalifornia.ca.gov to find a low-cost savings or checking account program near you.

Don't miss out on the CalEITC by not filing your taxes!



Remember, it's never too late to file your taxes! If you are eligible to receive the California and Federal EITC but don't file, you could be leaving up to \$6,000 on the table.
